



Apprenticeships explained

Anyone who lives in England and is over 16 years old can apply for an apprenticeship with the levels dependent on their current skills and qualifications. Generally an apprenticeship takes between 1 and 4 years to complete, and should include an appropriate work-based qualification (such as an NVQ), technical qualification (linked to the role), key skills (such as communication) as well as any other qualifications the employer feels is relevant.

With the government planning to create three million apprenticeships by the end of 2019, British manufacturer Vent-Axia is committed to being a part of this long standing tradition in the UK to up skill the next generation.

The rationale behind apprenticeships in the UK has been to plug the serious skills gaps in the country's workforce. Within Vent-Axia we look to apprenticeships and NVQ's to ensure our people are continuing to develop or enhance their skills whether that is within operational, administrative, customer facing or technical roles.

We believe that apprenticeships should be able to provide the employer and the apprentice with a worthwhile and beneficial experience.
